Phases of Current Student Housing Assignments

- ▶ Phase 1 → Apply for Housing
 - ► February 20 March 10
 - All students who plan to live on-campus must complete the application
- ▶ Phase 2 → Pre-Lottery Assignments
 - ▶ March 11 March 27
 - ▶ (RAs, CRAs, Honors, Greek Chapter Facilities, Programmatic students, etc)
- ▶ Phase 3 → Housing Lottery
 - March 28 only
 - Most students will select an assignment during Lottery
- ▶ Phase 4 → Post-Lottery Assignments
 - March 29 August 21
 - Housing Office processes assignments throughout the summer

Things To Remember for Current Freshmen/Rising Sophomores

- Current Freshmen (Class of 2020) are required to live oncampus for the full 2017-2018 academic year!
- Classification for Housing is determined by years out of high school NOT credit hours!!!
 - > The exceptions to living on-campus for sophomores are:
 - > Not returning to TCU
 - > Living at home in Fort Worth with your parent/legal guardian
 - Leasing privately at the GrandMarc
 - > Over 21 years of age before classes begin
 - > Please email housing@tcu.edu as soon as possible if you meet any of these criteria

Junior/Senior <u>Assignment</u> Cancellation Policy

▶ BEFORE June 1 No Cancellation fee

▶ June 1 – July 1 \$1,000 Cancellation fee

July 2 – Move In \$2,000 Cancellation fee

After Move In Full semester charges

- > This does NOT apply to students who withdraw from TCU.
- If you have NOT been assigned housing at the time of your cancellation, you will not be assessed a cancellation fee!!
- You are agreeing to an ACADEMIC YEAR housing license, even if you are a Junior or Senior!!
