Phases of Incoming Freshmen Housing Assignments

▶ Phase 1 → Apply to TCU

- ▶ Pay the \$900 non-refundable Enrollment Deposit or an approved waiver. For more information about this requirement, please contact TCU Admission at (817)257-7490.
- ▶ Submit the appropriate Meningitis Vaccination record to the TCU Health Center. For more information on this requirement, please visit: <http://healthcenter.tcu.edu/wp-content/uploads/2018/04/Meningitisform.pdf>

▶ Phase 2 → Apply for Housing

- ▶ Submit your Housing Application between April 1 – May 15 via my.tcu.edu.
 - ▶ The Enrollment Deposit and Meningitis Vaccination record must be on-file before you can access the housing application.

▶ Phase 3 → Housing Lottery

- ▶ May 23 → Extended Housing Lottery via Self-Selection. Only for students interested in selecting a space in discounted extended housing (extended triples, converted lounges, and triples-to-quads)
- ▶ June 29 → General Housing Lottery via Self-Selection (some students will still assign into extended housing)

▶ Phase 4 → Post-Lottery Assignments & Waitlist

- ▶ June 30 until Fall Move In
- ▶ You can submit a housing request via email to Housing@tcu.edu beginning on June 30 and the Housing Staff will work on changes and assignments throughout the spring and summer!

Incoming Freshmen Housing Application

- ▶ April 1 – May 15 via my.tcu.edu
 - ▶ You must have the Enrollment Deposit and Meningitis Vaccination record on-file before you access the housing application
- ▶ In the Housing Application, you will complete the following sections:
 - ▶ Review/Accept the Academic Year Campus Housing License
 - ▶ Complete the Housing Survey
 - ▶ Complete the First-Year Questionnaire
 - ▶ Form a Roommate Group [if you have preferred roommate(s)]
 - ▶ Select a Meal Plan
 - ▶ Select a Laundry Service *optional*

Incoming Freshmen Housing Lottery

- ▶ **Who:** Incoming Freshmen (Class of 2023) with a completed Housing App
- ▶ **What:** Select your housing space for the upcoming academic year
- ▶ **When:** Thursday, May 23 for students interested in selecting an extended housing space that is at a discounted rate (extended triples, converted lounges, etc) **OR** Saturday, June 29 for remaining extended housing spaces and traditional housing options
- ▶ **Where:** my.tcu.edu

Things To Remember for Incoming Freshmen

- Incoming Freshmen (Class of 2023) are required to live on-campus for two academic years!
- Classification for Housing is determined by years out of high school NOT credit hours!!!
- The exceptions to living on-campus as an incoming freshmen are:
 - Living at home within 30 miles of campus with your parent/legal guardian
 - Over 21 years of age before classes begin
 - Married and/or dependent children living with you
 - Veteran
 - Enrolled in fewer than 9 hours
 - Please email housing@tcu.edu as soon as possible if you meet any of these criteria

 - ▶ Suites, Extended Triples, Lounges
- ▶ Sherley
 - ▶ Doubles, Triples, Extended Triples, Extended Trip-to-Quad, Lounges
- ▶ Waits
 - ▶ Doubles, Suites, Triples, Extended Triples, Lounges
- ▶ Upper-Division Halls (The Commons or Worth Hills)
 - ▶ Private bedrooms, shared restroom

What are my room options in the Freshmen residence halls?

- ▶ Double → 2 person bedroom with 2 XL-Twin Beds; community restroom
- ▶ Suite → 2 person bedroom with 2 XL-Twin Beds; attached restroom
- ▶ Triple → 3 person bedroom with 3 XL-Twin Beds; community or attached restroom (noted on the Housing Portal during Lottery)
- ▶ Extended Triple → 2 person bedroom with 3 XL-Twin Beds; community or attached restroom (noted on the Housing Portal during Lottery)
- ▶ Extended Trip-to-Quad → 3 person bedroom with 4 XL-Twin Beds; community restroom
- ▶ Lounge → 2, 3 or 4 person bedroom with 2,3 or 4 XL-Twin Beds; community restroom
- ▶ Single → 1 person bedroom with 1 XL-Full bed; community restroom
